 - b. Alexandria Fire Fighters Local 2141, Union President, Megan Ellzy - Request has been made to City Manager and City Council to increase firefighter salaries to match neighboring jurisdictions. Additionally, a request has been made to increase staffing in order to meeting National Fire Protection Agency recommendation as well as decrease overtime spend.
